Introduction

The ENT surgery service posts consist of 12 months of full time clinical work, one position based at Modbury Hospital and one position based at Lyell McEwin Hospital. Applicants will preference what location they wish to work at in the application form. There are very good opportunities for the service registrars to be exposed to a wide range of ORLHNS surgical procedures including general ENT procedures, otology, facial plastics, rhinology, and some head & neck procedures.

Hospitals and services within the NALHN include the Lyell McEwin Hospital (LMH), Modbury Hospital, a range of sub-acute and primary health care services and a number of state-wide services.

What you can expect from the Modbury ENT post

Provide a short overview of the role, what should employees expect? Are employees in the same unit for 12 months?	<p>The Modbury ENT surgery service post consists of 12 months of full time clinical work.</p> <p>There are very good opportunities for the service registrars to be exposed to a wide range of ORLHNS surgical procedures including general ENT procedures, otology, facial plastics, rhinology, and some head & neck procedures.</p> <p>The ENT surgery service post at Modbury Hospital is designed for a trainee who has a strong interest in ENT, who has a strong interest in pursuing in the career of Otolaryngology Head & Neck Surgery.</p> <p>The applicants must have sound basic knowledge and clinical skills in ENT as a prerequisite requirement for job application. Modbury ENT service registrar is responsible of clinical care of ENT inpatients (including ward rounds, administrative work, consults), outpatients clinic, operating under supervision, ENT consults on the ward and at ED, after hours on call, teaching and research, annual temporal bone course and research.</p>
What are the key outcomes of the program?	By the end of 12 months employment, the trainee will have excellent exposure and training in general ENT, otology, facial plastics and rhinology.
Are contracts renewed every 12 months?	This is only a 12 month contract.
What are the hours of work and overtime?	Generally 8am to 5pm during the week; on call after hours few nights a week.
What education is provided?	Clinical teaching by ENT consultants and Accredited Registrar.

Indicate how the supervision will be provided, will this vary from rotation to rotation?	Continuous supervision provided by is Accredited Registrar and consultants
Will I spend time at other sites?	Currently LMH ENT service registrar does share on call (one in three days) with Modbury ENT service registrar and Modbury SET trainee as part of the RAH /Modbury/LMH on call system. However, LMH service registrar is never rostered to attend any clinic or operating theatre at Modbury Hospital. Modbury service registrar is also not rostered to do any clinic or theatre list at LMH. Only SET trainee at Modbury does an operating list at LMH once every 4 weeks.
Will the TMO supervise interns/others in their role?	TMO is responsible for supervision of medical student.

What you can expect from the Lyell McEwin ENT post

Provide a short overview of the role, what should employees expect? Are employees in the same unit for 12 months?	<p>At the Lyell McEwin Hospital, the very busy Accident and Emergency Centre, the growing size of the hospital in general and development of Oncology services impacts on the pattern of work performed.</p> <p>All ages of patients are treated through paediatric to geriatric and all areas of ENT care is covered. This includes Otology, Rhinology and Laryngology in general. More specifically paediatric ear and airway disease, endoscopic sinus surgery with functional rhinoplasty, laryngology and airway surgery for sleep apnoea and endoscopic ear surgery for chronic inflammatory ear disease.</p> <p>There is a large radiology department and dedicated audiology support on site, with speech and swallowing pathologists, dieticians and specialist trained nursing staff.</p> <p>This is a full time clinical work in LM hospital.</p>
What are the key outcomes of the program?	By the end of 12 months employment, the trainee will have excellent exposure and training in general ENT, otology, facial plastics and rhinology.
Are contracts renewed every 12 months?	This is only a 12 month contract.

What are the hours of work and overtime?	Generally 8am to 5pm during the week; on call after hours few nights a week.
What education is provided?	Support is given for attendance for continued professional development at courses locally and nationally, together with research and presentations to medical meetings. There is a planned programme for teaching undergraduate and postgraduate medical staff and nursing staff within the hospital.
Indicate how the supervision will be provided, will this vary from rotation to rotation?	Continuous supervision is provided by senior registrar and consultants
Will I spend time at other sites?	The trainee would be part of the on call service at Modbury Hospital and may need to attend ENT clinics and operating lists at the Modbury Hospital. Currently LMH ENT service registrar shares on call (one in three days) with Modbury ENT service registrar and Modbury SET trainee as part of the RAH /Modbury/LMH on call system. However, LMH service registrar is never rostered to attend any clinic or operating theatre at Modbury Hospital. Modbury service registrar is also not rostered to do any clinic or theatre list at LMH. Only SET trainee at Modbury does an operating list with Dr Sheldon Chong at LMH once every 4 weeks.
Will the TMO supervise interns/others in their role?	TMO is responsible for supervision of medical students

Selection into ENT Surgery Service positions

About the selection panel

The interview panel consists of Modbury and Lyell McEwin ENT consultants.

Eligibility

Only PGY2 + with full medical registration with AHPRA and must be an Australian permanent resident /citizen.

Skills and knowledge required for the role

Applicants must have had at least 2-3 months experience in ENT as an intern or resident in one of the ENT unit in Australia or overseas.

Selection Process

Our approach to selection

Based on CV, referee reports and interview. Network based approach to selection for selection, ranking and interviews. I.e. single interview covering both sites.

Your application

A minimum of three referee reports, a cover letter and a CV.

Curriculum vitae

Include:

- > Academic and clinical achievement;
- > Experience and training in ENT;
- > Research and publications.

Cover letter

A single page of cover letter addressing the reasons of applying for Modbury/LMH ENT, career aspirations.

Other application questions

There will be no mandatory question in the application sheet. A cover letter is required and should address the skills and knowledge required for the role.

Interview

Suitable candidates who have excellent cv, and referee reports will be shortlisted for interview. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified for interview.

The interview panel consists of Modbury and Lyell McEwin ENT consultants.
