
WHY IS THIS CENTRALISED EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS DIFFERENT?

WHY IS THIS CENTRALISED EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS DIFFERENT?

- Streamlined process.
- Single Expression of Interest submission.
- Select up to four training positions.
- Order training positions from most preferred to least preferred.
- You will not need to attend as many interviews.
- Review one training position offer.

TYPES OF TRAINING POSITIONS






TYPES OF TRAINING POSITIONS

- Entry into Vocational or Pre-specialty Training
 - Medicine and surgical specialty areas.
 - May need to be accepted by relevant College prior to appointment.
 - Full list of training positions available on the <u>SA Health Careers</u> website.
- General (non-specialty) Training
- Some positions are recruited outside of this centralised process.
 - Visit the <u>SA Health Careers</u> website.

IMPORTANT DATES FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Expression of Interest open date: Wednesday 14 June 2023 (9.00am)

Expression of Interest close date: Thursday 6 July 2023 (midnight)

Referee close date: Thursday I 3 July 2023 (5.00pm)

Preference reorder option closes: Thursday 3 I August 2023 (5.00pm)

Round I offers commences: Thursday I4 September 2023 – First or highest possible preference ONLY.

Round 2 offers commences: Thursday 21 September 2023 – Second or highest possible preference – excluding General Training.

Round 3 offers commences: Thursday 28 September 2023 – Third or highest possible preference – excluding General Training.

Round 4 offers commences: Thursday 5 October 2023 – Forth or highest possible preference – including General Training.

Offers made until all training positions are full and/or the rank list is exhausted.

Round 5 offers commences: Thursday 12 October 2023 – Offers will then continue as declines and withdrawals are received.

ELIGIBILITY FOR 2024 TRAINING POSITIONS


All applicants must:

- **be eligible for General Registration** as a medical practitioner in Australia issued by the Medical Board of Australia on/or before the February start date.
- you must be available to commence your contract on the February start date.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM

General Information

- Personal information name, address, contact details.
- Proof that you will have General Registration by the February start date:
 - The form will direct you to upload evidence e.g. provisional registration, AMC Certificate etc.
- Residency status Passport or citizenship certificate.

Part-time Work

- Can request within Expression of Interest.
- Job share partner is ideal Expressions of Interest should match (e.g. preference, nominate each other in Expression of Interest).
- Once allocated to a training position negotiate arrangements with LHN.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM - RESUME

- Resume include:
 - Academic and Vocational History
 - Employment History
 - Research
 - Audits
 - Training, courses etc.


EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FORM - REFEREE REPORTS

- You must supply three referees name, email and phone number.
- Review their contact details.
- Make sure your referee consents to be contacted and will not be on leave.
- Referees are sent a link to an online referee report form.
- Email with referee link is sent after you have submitted your Expression of Interest.
- Your status in your SA Health Careers Applicant account will be updated when a referee responds.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that all referees complete the electronic form by the due date.
- Referee reports are confidential, you will not receive a copy.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - TRAINING POSITION PREFERENCES

- You may preference up to four training positions.
- Select training positions from most preferred to least preferred.
- When you preference a training position the Expression of Interest form will direct you to provide further information (e.g. cover letter, answer questions etc).



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - TRAINING POSITION PREFERENCES

- If you are applying for training positions which are similar (e.g. BPT in three LHNs), please only provide your cover letter / response for the first BPT preference in your Expression of Interest.
- If you are applying for training positions which are very different (e.g. BPT, surgical resident, general training), we recommend that you tailor your response for those individual training positions.
- Information Packs will help you to understand the position requirements and desirable applicant features, visit the <u>SA Health Careers</u> website.
- Reflect on your experiences thus far, use what you have learned to describe why you are the best applicant for the training position. Think about your career direction and describe how you wish to achieve that.
- Only preference training positions that you are willing to accept!

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - SCREENING

- Employment and Health Screening
 - If you do not have these checks you will not be ineligible.
 - However, you will require these checks to commence employment.
- Document uploads: docx, doc, pdf, jpg only, less than 2MB in size.

DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

- Expression of Interest checked for completion.
- Eligibility is confirmed.
- Document verification and cross-checking as required e.g. MBA Registration status.
- Expression of Interest not approved if incomplete, or false/misleading information is provided.

SELECTION AND RANKING - PROCESS

- Merit based selection process.
- Initial selection is based on Expression of Interest and the information provided (e.g. cover letter).
- Interview with panel members (use the contact person specified within the training program Information Pack if you have questions).
- Expressions of Interest are ranked by (clinical) panel members.

If you change your mind you will have the option to amend the order of your training program preferences or withdraw preferences after submitting your Expression of Interest up until 3 I August 2023.



Example 3 - NOT ACCEPTABLE



ALLOCATION

- You must be deemed as appointable to receive a training position offer.
- Applicants are matched to their highest possible preference provided they are deemed as appointable and there are training positions vacant for that preference.
- First round training position offers will be made to applicants matched to their first or highest possible preference ONLY.
- Second round training position offers will be made to applicants matched to their first or second preference excluding GT/GP.
- Third round training position offers will be made to matched applicants excluding GT/GP.
 - A pause in GT/GP positions means there is a higher chance you can receive your first preference.
- Fourth round and beyond training position offers will be made until all positions (including GT/GP) are full and/or the
 rank list is exhausted.
- Training position offers will then continue as declines are received.

ACCEPT OR DECLINE - TRAINING POSITION OFFER

- Training position offers received via email.
- Accept or decline training position offer, within stated time frame via <u>SA Health Careers</u> Applicant account.
- If declined, no other training position offers will be made through this Expression of Interest process.
- No response within the stated time frame, offer will automatically be declined and that training position will be
 offered to the next ranked applicant.
- Withdraw via <u>SA Health Careers</u> Applicant account, or email <u>HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au</u> should you no longer be interested in receiving a training position offer from us.
- Email <u>HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au</u> if you have accepted a training position offer and wish to withdraw.

LATE VACANCY MANAGEMENT

- Some late vacancies may occur due to applicants withdrawing after the allocations process has been completed.
- Applicants who do not receive a training position offer throughout the centralised allocation process will be included in the Late Vacancy Management Process.
- You will be informed via email if your Expression of Interest will be included in this process.
- You may be contacted directly by Training Program Coordinators to fill these late vacancies.
- Training position offers will be made via email from the SA MET Team.


EMPLOYMENT CONTRACTS

- The LHN will issue the employment contract (subject to change).
- Generally occurs November and December each year.









MATCHING OUTCOME SUMMARY

- Matched to first preference of NALHN BPT
- Could have been matched to both NALHN BPT or CALHN GT/GP
- Total number of BPT positions is 55.
- 15 NALHN BPT positions ranked 17th match made
- 122 CALHN GT/GP positions ranked 55th could have been matched. This position will be offered to another applicant.




MATCHING OUTCOME SUMMARY

- Matched to second preference of NALHN Surg RMO
- Cannot be matched to first preference not ranked.
- Total number of Surg RMO positions is 59.
- 4 positions for NALHN Surg RMO ranked 3rd match made



MATCHING OUTCOME SUMMARY

- Matched to second preference of NALHN BPT
- Could have been matched to both NALHN BPT or NALHN GT/GP
- Total number of BPT positions is 55.
- 25 CALHN + 15 NALHN BPT positions = 40. Ranked 36th match made
- 72 NALHN GT/GP positions ranked 43rd could have been matched. This position will be offered to another applicant.








