What is the purpose of an accreditation surveyor?

Accreditation surveyors are essential to the prevocational accreditation process, as you bring your own knowledge and expertise of the medical education environment.

Surveyors attend health services to conduct interviews and inspections for the purpose of assessment against the AMCs National standards and requirements for prevocational (PGY1 and PGY2) training programs and terms.

What will the workshop focus on?

On completion of the Surveyor Training Workshop, participants will be able to:

- ✓ review and analyse accreditation submission documentation and apply clinical governance and quality assurance principles to conduct a risk assessment
- ✓ apply the new National Standards to submission documentation and during the
 assessment visit to identify strengths and deficits requiring further investigation
- ✓ recognise the importance of confidentiality, determine conflict of interests and
 potential risks associated with an accreditation assessment
- ✓ understand the roles and responsibilities of surveyor members, team leaders and the guidance provided by the SA MET accreditation team.
