

Benefits of a Centralised Expression of Interest process



- Streamlined process.
- Single Expression of Interest submission.
- Select up to four training positions.
- Order training positions from most preferred to least preferred.
- You will not need to attend as many interviews.
- Review one training position offer.

Types of Training Positions




- Entry into Vocational or Pre-specialty Training
 - Medicine and surgical specialty areas.
 - May need to be accepted by relevant College prior to appointment.
- General (non-specialty) Training
 - General rotations through medical, surgical and emergency units
 - Are suitable if you have not yet decided on a specialist training program or wish to obtain more experience.
- Some positions are recruited outside of this centralised process.

Eligibility for 2025 Training Positions



All applicants must:

- **be eligible for General Registration** as a medical practitioner in Australia issued by the Medical Board of Australia on/or before the February start date.
- meet Ahpra and SA Health's recency of practice requirements
 - practiced as a medical officer with paid employment (not an observership) within 2 years at the time of submitting EOI
- **not have accepted** a Targeted Voluntary Separation Package from SA Government within the last 3 years.
- be available to commence your contract on the February start date.



- Personal information name, address, contact details.
- Medical registration certificate
- Residency status Passport / citizenship certificate
- Referee details
- Resume

- Employment History
- Research
- Audits


Expression of Interest - Part-Time Work



- Can request within Expression of Interest.
- Job share partner is ideal Expressions of Interest should match (e.g. preference, nominate each other in Expression of Interest).
- Once allocated to a training position negotiate arrangements with LHN.

Expression of Interest – Referee Reports

- Must provide contact details for three referees check they are willing and able first
 - Names, emails and phone numbers
 - Sent link to online form ensure the email provided is correct!
- It is your responsibility to ensure that all referees complete the electronic form by the due date.
 - You can check the status of your referee reports via your online expression of interest.
- Referee reports are confidential, you will not receive a copy.





Training Position Preferences



- You may preference up to four training positions.
- Select training positions from most preferred to least preferred.
- When you preference a training position the Expression of Interest form will direct you to provide further information (e.g. cover letter, answer questions etc).

Training Position Preferences



- If you are applying for training positions which are similar (e.g. BPT in three LHNs), only provide your cover letter / response for the first BPT preference in your Expression of Interest.
- If you are applying for training positions which are very different (e.g. BPT, surgical resident, general training), tailor your response for those individual training positions.
- Reflect on your experiences thus far, use what you have learned to describe why you are the best applicant for the training position. Think about your career direction and describe how you wish to achieve that.
- Only preference training positions that you are willing to accept!

Information Packs will help you to understand the

position requirements and desirable applicant characteristics

Document Verification

- Expression of Interest checked for completeness.
- Document verification and cross-checking as required
 - e.g. MBA Registration status.
- Expression of Interest will not be passed to the selection panels if:
 - incomplete or
 - false/misleading information is provided.

Preferences would revert to original selection

PGY2+ – Selection and Allocation



- Merit based selection process program selection panel will:
 - Review EOI and any other information provided (e.g. cover letter)
 - Organise interviews with shortlisted applicants
- Expressions of Interest will then be ranked by selection panel
- Applicants are matched to their highest possible preference provided:
 - Deemed as appointable
 - Training positions remain
- Offers commence from Thursday 19 September 2024
 - One offer only made by email

Allocation



- First round training position offers
 - Made to applicants matched to their first or highest possible preference ONLY.
- Second round training position offers
 - Made to applicants matched to their first or second preference (*excluding GT/GP*).
 - A pause in GT/GP positions = higher chance you can receive your first preference.
- Third round training position offers
 - will be made to matched applicants (*excluding GT/GP*).
- Fourth round and beyond training position offers will be made until all positions (including GT/GP) are full and/or the rank list is exhausted.
- Training position offers will then continue as declines are received.

Training Position Offers




- Offers made via email only one offer
- Accept or Decline training position offer, within stated time frame via <u>SA Health Careers</u> Applicant account.
 - If you decline you will not receive another offer through this Expression of Interest process.
 - If you don't respond within the stated time frame, offer will automatically be declined and that training position will be offered to the next ranked applicant.
- Withdraw via <u>SA Health Careers</u> Applicant account, or email <u>HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au</u> should you no longer be interested in receiving a training position offer from us.
- Email <u>HealthSAMET@sa.gov.au</u> if you have accepted a training position offer and wish to withdraw.
- Contracts are issued by the employing LHN

Late Vacancy Management



- Some late vacancies may occur due to applicants withdrawing after the allocations process has been completed.
- Applicants who do not receive a training position offer throughout the centralised allocation process will be included in the Late Vacancy Management Process.
- You will be informed via email if your Expression of Interest will be included in this process.
- You may be contacted directly by Training Program Coordinators to fill these late vacancies.
- Training position offers will be made via email from the SA MET Team.






Match Examples

- 140 positions for CALHN GT/GP ranked 29th could have been matched




MATCHING OUTCOME SUMMARY


- Matched to second preference of NALHN Surg RMO


